(Roseburg, Ore.) The Douglas County Board of Commissioners would like to remind citizens that government offices in the Douglas County Courthouse, located at 1036 SE Douglas Avenue in Roseburg, as well as the Douglas County Justice Building, Douglas County Courthouse Annex (Reedsport), Transfer Stations, Fairgrounds and All External Douglas County Government Offices will be closed to the public on **Thursday, November 25, 2021**, in observance of the Thanksgiving Day Holiday.

In addition, some County Departments will have limited hours, be lightly staffed or closed to the public on Friday, November 26, 2021. Please call ahead of your visit to see if the Department has staff available to assist you with your needs. You can call (541) 672-3311 for general inquires and Department extensions. Please note that Douglas County Senior Dining Sites – Curbside Meal Service and our Meals on Wheels Programs in Glendale, Glide, Yoncalla, Reedsport, Sutherlin, Riddle and Winston will be closed on Thursday, November 25 and Friday, November 26, 2021. Our Senior Dining sites will resume their drive-through meal and Meals on Wheels service on Tuesday, November 30, 2021. Patrons needing meals for Thursday and Friday are asked to request an extra meal during their drive-through visit or delivery on Tuesday, November 23, 2021.

As always, even when Douglas County government offices are closed, many officials and public employees are still working. Our Sheriff's Deputies, 911 communications and DCSO staff will continue to provide law enforcement protection and emergency assistance for our residents. If you have an emergency, call 9-1-1. If you need to reach dispatch for a non-emergency, call the Douglas County Sheriff's Office non-emergency number at (541) 440-4471. The Douglas County Commissioners, Dr. Bob Dannenhoffer, our Public Health Officer, DPHN staff, and Joint Information team will continue to work on the COVID-19 response regardless of the holiday.
