



Douglas County Parks Department Policy On Free Camping for Disabled Veterans and Active Military on Leave

Douglas County Parks Department allows Disabled Veterans with an **Oregon State Special Access Pass** issued by Oregon State Parks and **Active Military on Leave** to camp for free. Douglas County allows **10 days per year** with a maximum of 5 free days in a row at any Douglas County Parks campground at an individual campsite. The Oregon State Special Access Pass 'holder' is required to be present during entire camping stay.

Additional charges for extra vehicles, tents, etc., must be paid by you. To use all 10 days at the same D.C. Parks campground, there is a 30 day wait to return for an additional 5 nights. Group sites, cabins, yurts, and deluxe sites are not eligible. Holiday and special event rates do not apply. **Standard rates only.**

To receive free camping, you will have to arrive "ready to camp" in a "first come, first serve" status. **OR** call 541-957-7001 to reserve. Free nights will be credited at the time of booking.

To receive the same free camping as an OSSAP, active members of the military on leave need to only show their leave papers and military identification card.

Note: Our program was based on a similar program operated by the State of Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD); however, our restriction policies are very different.
