†Our COVID case update chart includes the total number of cases reported in Douglas County since the beginning of the pandemic in our county on March 8, 2020. The chart illustrates the combination of residents with positive test results and confirmed presumptives, as well as the breakout of each of those. There will be times when a presumptive will move to a positive test result, and our total case number will not change because the case has already been counted in our over-all total.

We follow the CDC definition for fully vaccinated and up-to-date, which states that a fully vaccinated person is someone who has received both doses of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine, or one dose of a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine and at least 14 days have passed since the individual's final dose. Up-to-date means they have completed the full series of the COVID-19 vaccine, and if eligible they have also gotten their booster, or if they are fully vaccinated, but not yet eligible for a booster.

As a reminder, as of Wednesday, December 1, 2021, our team shifted to a weekly release for our Douglas County COVID-19 Update.
