



What should I do with **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE?**

- Household hazardous waste can be leftover household products that can catch fire, react, or explode under certain circumstances or that are corrosive or toxic and cannot be disposed of at our landfill or transfer sites.
- Products, such as paints, cleaners, oils, batteries, and pesticides can contain hazardous ingredients and require special care when you dispose of them.
- Douglas County is working with Oregon DEQ to schedule a local household hazardous waste collection event in the near future. In the mean time, please check with our neighboring counties or Oregon DEQ for open collection events or disposal locations:
