## \*\*\* SUMMER ROAD IMPROVEMENT UPDATE \*\*\* Douglas County Public Works Chip Seal Program

(Douglas County, Ore.) – Douglas County Public Works Department (DCPW), Operations and Maintenance Division began work on their annual chip seal program on Douglas County roadways this week and plan to continue throughout the remainder of the summer. Chip seal work is set to be performed Monday through Friday, from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm, depending upon weather and materials availability. Traffic in the work areas will be controlled by flaggers. Please proceed with caution and obey all posted signs, warnings and flagging instructions.

The chip seal program is the application of a special protective wearing surface to an existing pavement. The surface treatment combines one or more layer(s) of asphalt with one or more layer(s) of fine aggregate.

DCPW will provide updates to the chip seal maintenance schedule, if and when any changes occur. The tentative schedule is as follows and is subject to modification:
