All Open Fires Not Allowed In Douglas County Owned Parks And Campgrounds

(Douglas County, Ore) Based on EXTREME fire danger and Douglas Forest Protective Association's (DFPA's) current [Public Use and Industrial IFPL Restrictions](#), the Douglas County Board of Commissioners, in conjunction with the Douglas County Parks Department would like to remind residents that all **OPEN** campfires are currently banned in **ALL** Douglas County owned and operated Parks and Campgrounds, pursuant to the current restrictions and EXTREME level conditions. Please note that propane gas heaters and lanterns are allowed at this time. We ask that you use exercise extreme caution and continue to be fire safe in everything you do in and around our parks and while outdoors.
