(Douglas County, Ore.) On May 24, 2021, after a two-week trial, a Douglas County jury convicted Tristan Ray Stanton (DOB: 04-17-87) of 29 counts, including Sodomy of a child under 12 years old, Unlawful Sexual Penetration of a child under 12, and Sexual Abuse of a child under 12 stemming from years of abuse of multiple children.

The trial was presided over by the Honorable Ann Marie Simmons and full COVID-19 protocols were in place to protect the jurors and witnesses. District Attorney Rick Wesenberg and Senior Deputy District Attorney Allison Eichmann prosecuted the case, which arose from the thorough investigation by Roseburg Police Department Detective, Justin Wesie, the Oregon State Police Forensic DNA Lab, and Douglas CARES. Sentencing is set for June 1, 2021 at 1:30 pm in Courtroom 402.
