We invite you to join us for the 2022 Veterans Day Parade in downtown Roseburg, Oregon. The rules that follow are designed for the safety and enjoyment of all participating.

CHECK IN OPENS: 9:00 a.m.

CHECK IN CLOSES: 10:00 a.m.

PARADE BEGINS: 11:00 a.m.

Check-In: Headquarters will be located on the corner of **Fowler** and **SE Douglas**. Follow the signs posted. Please have one representative check in and pick up your entry number. All entries must check in to receive their parade number and staging location. No support vehicles will be allowed in staging area.

ALL ENTRIES MUST DISPLAY THEIR ENTRY NUMBER AT ALL TIMES. Numbers will be picked up at the end of the parade.

POST ALL ENTRY NUMBERS ON THE FRONT, LEFT SIDE OF YOUR ENTRY.

Participants are reminded U.S. Code: Title 4: Chapter 8 provides guidelines regarding display of the Flag of the United States of America.

By State Law and for safety purposes, no items of any nature can be thrown from any entry. No throwing of Candy. We will provide volunteers to walk beside your entry and pass out Candy—NO THROWING. *See pg 3.**

All entries must obey instructions and take directions from parade control units, line-up crew, and police officers concerning the operating of vehicles.

All material used as decorations on floats should be flame retardant. *All floats must be equipped with UL approved fire extinguisher.*

No alcohol, narcotic, or intoxicants of any nature are to be consumed by drivers of vehicles or passengers in the parade.

Political campaigning of any kind is not allowed in the parade. **Entries advocating or depicting political or Social Issues will not be allowed in the parade.** *We are here to honor Veterans, not to promote Politics or Social Issues.*

Please decorate your floats, cars to honor our 2022 Grand Marshals, Navy Submarine Veterans.

Entries with large animals: As a courtesy to all other parade participants who are walking in the Parade, you are required to pick up and dispose of your animal waste along the parade route. (Bring a “pooper-scooper” with you)

All Parade participants are asked to *keep pace with the line of march.* Keep within 50 feet of the entry in front of you. *A 30 second stop to perform at reviewing is allowed.*

Parade Judging: Judging will take place during the parade. **For safety reasons you must remain in the parade for the whole route. Do not leave the parade after judging.** Awards will be announced the following week. Winners will be called and told how they can pick up their trophy or ribbon.

Deadline: Parade **application deadline, October 31, 2022 by 5 p.m.**

The Veterans Day Parade Committee reserves the right for safety or other purposes listed above, to deny entry either prior to or during the parade to any entry not adhering to the rules or following the directions of Law Enforcement personnel or Parade Officials.
